WHAT PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) TO WEAR (DURING PATIENT INTERACTION)

In line with Public Health England guidance (12 October 2020)

INSIDE PATIENT-CARE AREAS

Applies to all staff inside patient-care areas when more than 2 metres away from patients.



CLOSE CONTACT WITH PATIENTS (WITHIN 2 METRES) Applies to all staff who are less than 2 metres away from patients. Visor Fluid-resistant surgical mask Disposable gloves Disposable plastic apron

Some areas such as ICU and IDU may have specific PPE requirements. Please check local guidance.

Your safety, and the safety of others, depends on more than the PPE you use. Safe doffing and hand hygiene reduces the risk of self-contamination.





AEROSOL-GENERATING PROCEDURES (AGPS)*

Applies to all staff involved in AGPs including in areas where AGPs are not usually performed.
