*Cytology - urine	Sterile container (no formalin); not an EMU	2 days	In-house
FNA	Air-dried and fixed slides	2 days	In-house
Frozen section	Sterile container (no formalin)	1 hour	In-house
Immunohistochemistry tests (e.g. ER, PR, Her-2)	Tissue block/ slide	2 days	In-house and Referral Laboratories
Molecular tests (e.g. FISH)	Tissue block/ slide	7-25 days	Referral Laboratories
Routine histology (case requiring extra fixation time e.g. WLE breast, colon)	Formal saline pot	5 days	In-house
Routine histology case (small biopsy samples, skins)	Formal saline pot	3 days	In-house
